She played trombone in the band and graduated from Will Rogers High School, class of 1950, and also attended The University of Oklahoma. Alice married Bob Lees in 1953 and to this union bore 4 children whom she was very proud of. 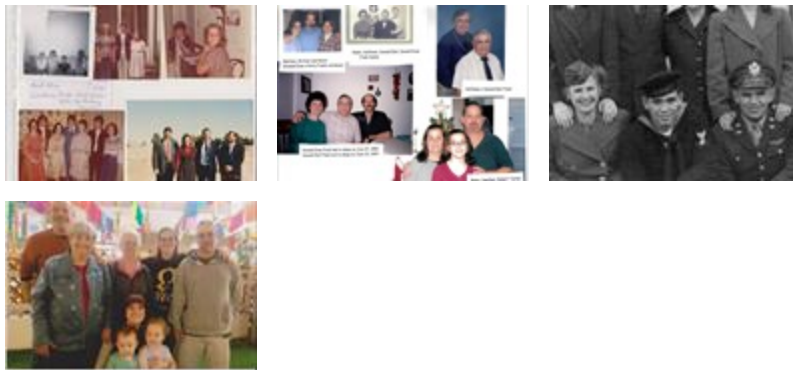
