



## Alice Ann "Andy" Noah

September 29, 1927 - October 11, 2017

Services honoring the life of Alice Ann "Andy" Noah have been scheduled for 2:00 p.m., Wednesday, October 18, 2017 at Hayhurst Funeral Home Chapel in Broken Arrow, Oklahoma. Burial will follow at Bixby Cemetery. Friends may visit the funeral home on Tuesday from 9:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m. with family there to receive visitors from 6:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m.

Alice Ann was born in Shawnee, Oklahoma on Thursday, September 29, 1927 to L.C. and Mary Louise (Conrad) Montgomery. Alice Ann passed away on Wednesday, October 11, 2017 at the age of 90.

Alice Ann attended school at Bowlegs until her junior year when she transferred and graduated from Seminole High School in 1944. She attended St. John's School of Nursing, earning her RN Certificate. Known as Andy to faculty and Nurse Noah to students, she enjoyed a successful career as the very first and beloved school nurse at Broken Arrow Public Schools.

Alice Ann married Howard Edward Noah on March 4, 1950 in Tulsa, Oklahoma and their union was blessed with two daughters. Alice Ann was a loving and devoted wife, mother and grandmother. She adored her family and loved spending time with them.

Alice Ann had many interests and was a tireless volunteer in her community.

She was a founding member of the Broken Arrow Pilot Club and the Broken Arrow Salvation Army Women's Auxiliary. She was active in her St John's alumni group and Bowlegs High School Alumni Association. She was an avid supporter of the University of Oklahoma. Alice Ann was an active member of Arrow Heights Baptist Church for over fifty years. She belonged to the Kappa Kappa Iota Sorority. She served as an Ambassador for the Tulsa International Airport through the RSVP program. She was also a Campfire Leader, PTA member and a band parent.

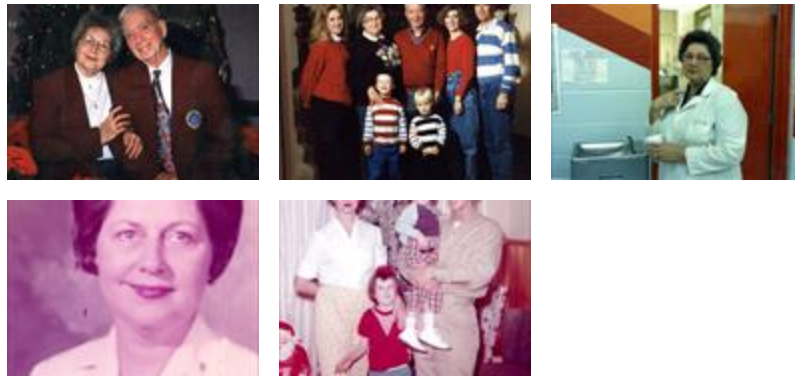

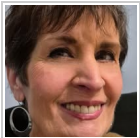
