October 30, 1949 - June 23, 2025

Barbara “Barb” Aasby, also known as “Bubsie”, was born on Sunday, October 30, 1949 in Madison, Wisconsin, the daughter of Gust M. and Adeline “Ad” E. (Boullack) Liebelt. She passed this life on Monday, June 23, 2025 at her home in Tulsa. She was 75 years of age.

The former Miss Barb Liebelt was a 1967 graduate of Robert M. LaFollette High School in Madison, Wisconsin. She married Loren A. Aasby on July 24, 1971 in Des Moines, Iowa. Loren preceded her in death on March 28, 2017.

Barb and Loren met at the “Crown Family Restaurant” in Des Moines, Iowa. Barb was waiting tables and attending Junior College and while Loren was and playing baseball and attending Iowa State. Barb took Loren’s order for a cup of coffee and a slice of pie and the rest is history. They would later find out that Barb’s cousin Roger Liebelt was dating Loren’s twin sister Lori at the same time! That is how the Liebelt/Aasby saga began!

Most of her career, Barb worked as an Executive Secretary for Marriott. She eventually went to work at Methodist Manor, until she retired to help care for her 2 granddaughters, Madi and Sami. 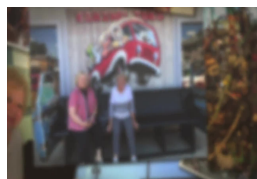

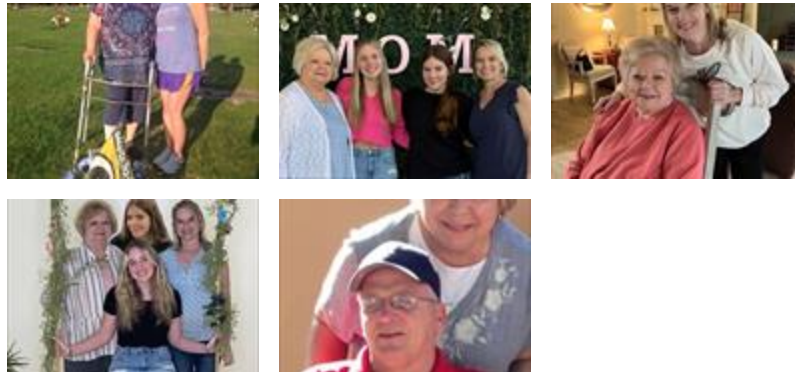
