Barbara Brown Kimbrough was born August 18, 1931 in Bixby, Oklahoma, the daughter of Ivan and Estella (Lewis) Brown. She died in Tulsa on Friday, June 19, 2015. She was 83 years of age.

The former Miss Barbara Brown grew up in Bixby, attending school there and graduated from Holland Hall in 1949. She received a degree in Home Economics from Oklahoma A. & M. where she was a member of the Kappa Kappa Gamma Sorority.
