November 7, 1943 - March 9, 2018

Basker Johnson died on March 9, 2018 at Clarehouse in Tulsa, Oklahoma. He was born on November 7, 1943, at the Pikeville, Kentucky, hospital to Joe and Sarah (Hall) Johnson of Harold, Kentucky. The family soon relocated to Blaine, Kentucky. Basker was raised there and graduated from Blaine High School in 1960 and Mayo Vocational School in 1961. In September 1961 he began work as a stenographer for the Federal Bureau of Investigation in Washington, D.C., where he met and in 1963 married Bonnie Jean Meyer. In late 1965 they moved to Tulsa, Oklahoma and in May, 1966, moved to Sapulpa where they raised their son William, and daughter, Elizabeth. In 2008, they relocated to Broken Arrow. After Bonnie's death in 2013, he met and married Terry Hixson Buttress. He worked in Tulsa several years while attending night school to become a Certified Public Accountant. From 1980 until his recent retirement he operated an accounting and tax practice in Sapulpa. Basker loved the Lord and was active in his church for many years serving as a board member, treasurer, deacon, and elder. He was also active in his community as a member of the Sapulpa Kiwanis Club and the Sapulpa Area Chamber of Commerce.
