April 3, 1924 - November 12, 2019

Betty J (Spearman) Beebe was born in Ainsworth, Nebraska on April 3, 1924. She died in Tulsa, Oklahoma on November 12, 2019. She was raised by her mom, Ethel Spearman and was part of the group known as "The girls". This included her twin sisters, Jean (Rohde) and Jeanette (Fox) who were 14 months older.

Betty graduated from Ainsworth High School and was Salutatorian of her Senior Class. She taught for two years in a one room school house in Brown County, Nebraska. She had to walk a mile to the school house and go early to put coal in the stove so the classroom would be warm.

In 1943 she married Carlyle Beebe who was a young Pastor ministering in Nebraska, Idaho, and South Dakota. She was the consummate pastor's wife demonstrating hospitality and serving her husband's congregations. Her talents included playing the piano, teaching, feeding the homeless that Carlyle would bring home, all done with a gracious smile. She had a great desire to memorize scripture which included hundreds of verses from the Bible including the complete books of James and I&2 Peter.

She was Mom to Carlene Beebe Quist (Carl) of Tulsa, Oklahoma, Joyce of Rapid City, South Dakota and Ron of Rapid City. She was Grandma to Nathan and Nicole Quist and Ben (Janelle) and Blake Beebe. Her greats are Parker

and Everly Beebe, the joy of her later years.

Betty loved Jesus, loved her family including numerous nieces and nephews, and loved serving others. She accepted people for what there were, forgave them for what they were not, and loved unconditionally. This her legacy...a life well lived.
