The Ogdens were known for their delicious pears and other fruits from their orchard. After high school, she attended Weaver Airline Personnel School Kansas City, Missouri. From there she was hired by Braniff Airlines to be a teletypist, and she moved to Dallas.

She had met Jerry Davidson in high school, and he soon followed her to Dallas. They got married on April 28, 1956, in Meno, Oklahoma. Together they raised two children, Tim and Karen, who have great memories of airplane, beach, and fishing trips. In 1975, the Davidsons moved back to Oklahoma, building a home in Ringwood. Betty worked at Enid airport and a nurse tech. She was also the Ringwood correspondent for the Enid paper for a few years.
