Billy Joe Herring, Jr. was born on Tuesday, November 11, 1952 in Camp Roberts, California, the son of Billy Joe and Wanda Lou (Pridgen) Herring Sr. He passed this life on Sunday, March 10, 2024 at his home in Tulsa, Oklahoma. He was 71 years of age.

Bill was a 1970 graduate of Jenks High School. He received a Basketball scholarship to play basketball at Oral Roberts University, where he graduated in 1974 with a degree in education. He received a master degree from Northeastern State University in Industrial Management in 1991. He worked for Parker Drilling, TD Williamson, and Latshaw Drilling. 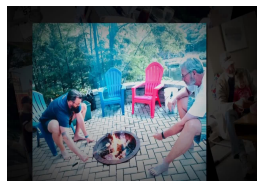
