Billy Lee Hickman, was born on Tuesday, March 14, 1939 in Oklahoma City, Oklahoma the Son of Burton Lee and Agnes Ann (Crews) Hickman. He passed this life on Tuesday, April 29, 2025 in Wilburton, Oklahoma. He was 86 years of age.

Billy was a graduate of 1956 Graduate of Central High School in Tulsa. He married the former Miss Sherry Offineer on June 10, 1958 in Sumter, South Carolina. She preceded Billy on November 20, 2022. They are together again in their Heavenly home. Billy was a veteran of the United States Air Force, having served from June 11, 1956 to June 10, 1960. Following his military service he received a Bachelor's in Theology from Oklahoma Baptist University in Shawnee, Oklahoma. Billy was licensed to preach on January 5, 1969 at Cincinnati Avenue Baptist Church in Tulsa and Ordained to Gospel Ministry on June 28, 1970 at Calvary Baptist Church in Holdenville. He pastored churches in Tulsa, Holdenville, Francis, Arkoma, Lawton, Broken Arrow and Enid, all in Oklahoma. He was the Director of Missions for the Sans Bois Baptist Association in Oklahoma from June 1, 1991 to December 1, 2007. During this time he was Interim Pastor for numerous churches in Oklahoma.
