Robert Lee Hannah was born in Valley Head, West Virginia to parents, William Franklin and Lina Leah (Hogan) Hannah on Wednesday November 2, 1927. He went to be with Jesus Friday morning, May 29, 2026 in Broken Arrow, Oklahoma at 98 years of age.

Bob was a 1946 high school graduate of Belington, West Virginia. He had two sisters, Betty and Virginia. When World War II started, he proudly served his country in the United States Navy. Bob met Peggy Ruth Flanagan, who was enamored by his smile and sweet ways, and they became sweethearts. Bob and Peggy were united in Holy Matrimony on Tuesday, September 5, 1950 in Elkins, West Virginia. They were married for almost 76 years. He was a tender and loving husband. As a career, Bob was a Design Engineer and employed by Martin Marietta until 1983 when he and Peggy retired.
