



Carl B. Rankin

October 8, 1929 - July 26, 2016

Services honoring the life of Carl B. Rankin have been scheduled for Friday, July 29, 2016. A graveside service will take place at 10:00 AM, Friday at Park Grove Cemetery in Broken Arrow, followed by an 11:00 AM service at Tulsa Bible Church. Friends may visit Hayhurst Funeral Home in Broken Arrow on Wednesday from 12:00 PM noon to 9:00 PM and Thursday from 9:00 AM to 9:00 PM. The family will greet friends from 6:00 to 8:00 PM, Thursday.

Carl Burton Rankin, 86, joined his wife Elsie with the Lord in heaven Tuesday, July 26, 2016. Carl was born on October 8, 1929 in Enid, OK. After proudly serving in the US Navy during the Korean War, Carl met Elsie, his future bride of 59 years, and married her a mere 63 days from their first introduction. Carl attended Oklahoma A&M (now Oklahoma State University). The couple then moved to Broken Arrow, OK where they raised 2 children and lived for 53 years until her death in January, 2015. Carl was employed by American Airlines where he worked in plant maintenance as a crew chief for 30 years. He was a longtime member of Tulsa Bible Church where he faithfully served in many ways but probably will most be remembered as a door greeter where his generous hugs and cheerful conversation were a constant on Sunday mornings for many, many years.

Carl is survived by his brother Kenny and his wife Joyce of Broken Arrow, daughter, Diana Schroeder and husband, Dennis of St. Amant, LA; his son

David Rankin and wife Laura of Greensboro, GA; his grandchildren Dana Gonzales and husband Presiliano, of Cypress, TX, Justin Schroeder and wife Michelle of Baoding, China, Doug Rankin of Portland, OR, and Scott Rankin of Milledgeville, GA; and precious great granddaughter Piper Schroeder of Baoding, China.

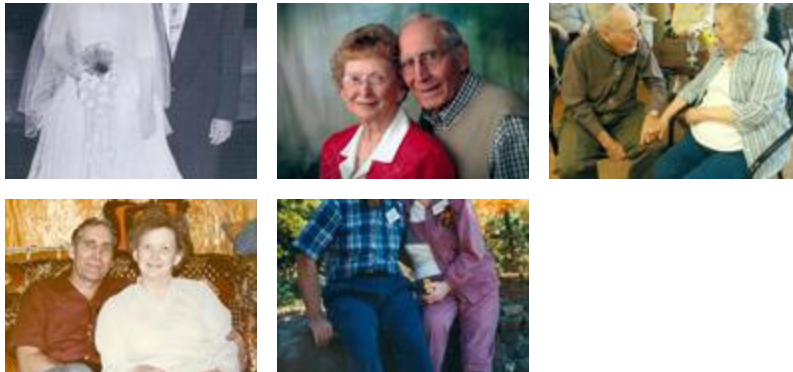
