Carmeletta Naomi Eidson, also known as Nana or Carm, passed away on November 8, 2023, in Tulsa, Oklahoma, at the age of 97. She was born on May 25, 1926, in Porum, Oklahoma, to her parents, Allen and Effie Barker. Effie was a preacher woman (Putnam City Assembly in Bethany, Ok) ordained in 1948, but also preached in the 1920's and 1930's when not many women were allowed to speak openly. Carm was a dedicated member of various places of worship throughout her life, including Capitol Hill Assembly, Lewis Avenue Assembly, and Woodlake Church. Her faith was an essential part of her life, and she actively participated in her church community. Carm's warm and loving nature extended beyond her personal interests. She taught a girls' Sunday School class for two decades, hosting numerous parties and outings for the girls to bond and connect. Her boys fondly remember her as the best mom and cook, creating a loving and nurturing family home.

In her early years, Carm attended Porum/Stigler High School in Oklahoma and later

pursued her education at Tulsa Business College. After completing her studies, she

worked as a typist and secretary before devoting her time to raising her children.

Beyond her professional endeavors, Carm had a passion for writing and authored "The

Nana Book." She was also an avid quilter and enjoyed exploring her family's genealogy.

Carm's creative spirit and dedication to her hobbies brought her joy and fulfillment

throughout her life.

Carmeletta Naomi Eidson will be deeply missed by her family, friends, and all who had

the privilege of knowing her. Her legacy of love, faith, and creativity will continue to

inspire those whose lives she touched. She didn't have any enemies; she was a

peacemaker.

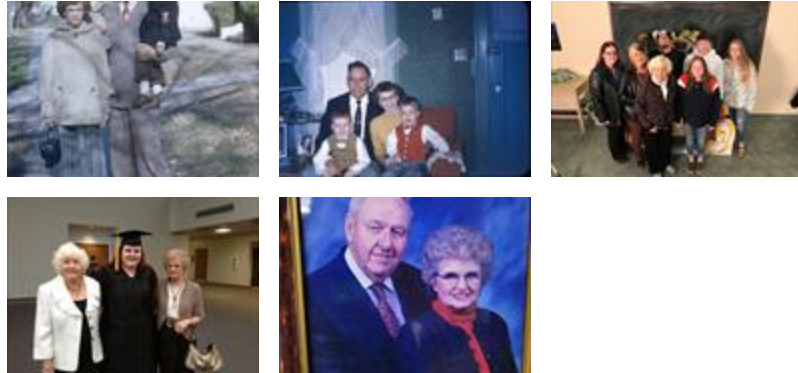
