Carole Coder Howard, DO, age 69, of Broken Arrow, OK departed this life on Tuesday, June 28, 2022. She was born September 20, 1952 to James and Anne (Gorton) Coder of La Belle, Missouri. Carole attended school through the 12th grade in LaBelle. She was joined in marriage to James Lewis Howard on December 20, 1970.

Carole attended Northeast Missouri State Teachers College from 1970 to 1972 and graduated from Kirksville College of Osteopathic Medicine in 1976. 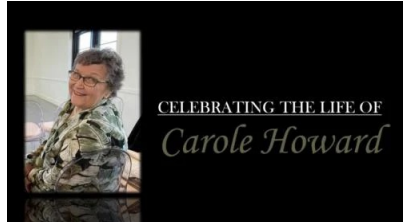

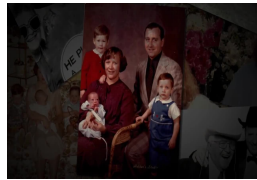

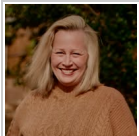
