After a few years of teaching, she needed a break, so she became a cab driver and owned 3 taxi cabs, 2 she leased out to other drivers and 1 she drove full time. After a number of years, she wanted to travel so she went back to school and obtained her CDL to become an over the road truck driver

and did this for a number of years.

She lived in many states and met lots of people and experienced life in a big way. When she was finished traveling and driving, she returned home to Oklahoma City and went back to work teaching at Classen School until she retired.

In 2003 she moved to Broken Arrow to be with her family and grandchildren where she enjoyed reading, going to church, genealogy research, watching old westerns, mysteries on TV, working in her yard, garden and many flower beds where she could make anything grow, even bringing a stick back to life!

She left behind a legacy of 2 sons, Kevin and Phillip, Daughter Lynn, 4 grandchildren Brandon, David, Nicki, Samantha and their spouses Sarah, Rachel, Chris and Zach as well as 9 wonderful great grandchildren, Sara, Parker, Patton, Kennedy, Morgan, Barnabas, Amy, Theodore, and Phenli, and agreed that 3 more to make an even dozen would be great!

She lived a long and wonderful life through many hard and very interesting times, she will be missed, but we know she is with her heavenly Father in Heaven and will see here again when we all get to Heaven one day!
