



Carolyn "Sue" Cook

January 2, 1948 - June 3, 2019

Carolyn Sue Cook, known by friends and family simply as Sue, died at Hillcrest South Hospital early Monday morning, June 3, 2019.

Born and named Carolyn Sue Bond in Oklahoma City on January 2, 1948 – just after the end of World War II. The average cost of a new car was just a little over \$1,000.00 – the cost of a gallon of gas was .16 cents. Carolyn Sue Bond married Raymond Melvin Cook on December 3, 1965 in Midwest City Oklahoma. She and Raymond lived in an around Midwest City, and for many years in Harrah, Oklahoma, moving to Tulsa in 2008 – continually improving and landscaping her front yard until it was the center piece of the block. Sue enjoyed boating and camping, and making her home a comfortable and happy place for husband and only daughter, Stephanie Dawn Cook. Sue and Raymond were most happily married for 53 years.

She had varied interests, cosmetologist, interior decorator, flowers and gardening. She enjoyed talking to her neighbor's as one of Jehovah's Witnesses. For those brief 71 years, she packed in a lot of living, tirelessly busy with work and including driving a truck for Western Dairy.
