



## Rev. Charlie Yandell

January 24, 1928 - December 3, 2016

Services honoring the life of Rev. Charlie Yandell have been scheduled for 1:00 PM, Thursday, December 8, 2016 at Carbondale Assembly of God in Tulsa, Oklahoma.

Charlie L. Yandell was born on January 24, 1928 in Webbers Falls, Oklahoma. He was the son of Ninevah Alexander and Martha Florence (Hudson) Yandell. He was the youngest son of eleven children. He passed from this earth on Saturday, December 3, 2016 in Tulsa, Oklahoma. He was an ordained minister with the Assemblies of God for more than 58 years.

He married his sweetheart, Rosie (Bates) on September 4, 1954 in Tulsa, Oklahoma. Together they began a journey of ministry and pastoring across Oklahoma and a brief time in Louisiana. The congregations that they pastored include Hammond Assembly of God in Louisiana; Prue Assembly of God; Pawnee Assembly of God; Turley Assembly of God; First Assembly of God in Henryetta; and Central Assembly of God in Edmond.

Charlie was a gifted songwriter and wrote numerous Gospel songs. "Now I Have Everything" was the most well-known song he wrote and was recorded by several Christian and Gospel artists throughout the years.

He was a veteran of the U.S. Army and served during World War II.
