“Charlotte became a part of my class in the 7th grade at Catoosa, OK. She made our class better. Charlotte was involved with most everything in school, but her favorite class was Chorus. Mr. Tucker was a great teacher, and I believe she claimed him as her favorite. We had trips to Stillwater, and had the honor and memorable experience, of being a part of an amazing event in the Iba Arena (at least twice, but maybe more) at OSU. High Schools from the NE part of Oklahoma filled the Arena. I'm not sure of the month, but it seems to me it was before Christmas. We all sang several songs together, but the closing was our favorite, The Hallelujah Chorus. It always gave me goose bumps to hear hundreds of young voices together sing a song with such dynamic praise to our Lord. Those were such fun and impressionable days of our lives that we both remembered. Charlotte was a member of our Class Reunion Committee for years; and she put her heart into planning for these fun times of seeing our old friends.



Charlotte was the happiest person in the world to have her grandson, Tyler Click. He was wise beyond his years. I forget how old he was when he developed a keen interest in the assassination of John F. Kennedy, on November 22, 1963. You could ask him anything, and he knew the answer. The same is true for the Titanic. He could quote all of the facts of that catastrophic event in history. I'm guessing that Tyler was somewhere in the 5-8 age range when he developed such deep interests.

Tyler is loved by all who know him, but none could love him more than his Nana, who beamed with great pride of her outstanding grandson. My husband and I had the delight of watching Tyler grow up. He accompanied his Nana several times when she came to our home. In his early years, he was sincerely interested in adults, and loved people of all ages, just like his Nana Charlotte did.

Charlotte deeply loved all of her huge family, scattered throughout the USA. As she laid near death, several cousins from various

locations came to bid her farewell. Several years ago, Charlotte and I started trying to attend our classmates' funerals, and their immediate family members. We referred to ourselves as the "Self-Appointed Funeral Committee." Fact being, another classmate, Dayle James' funeral was being held one hour after Charlotte's, in Okmulgee. Our great friend and classmate, Lyle Brumley, attended his service. In the last year, when Charlotte's health was tanking, I knew that when she died, it would be our last funeral together. That weighs heavily on me. We loved each other dearly.

If you knew Charlotte well, you were aware that she loved music, especially that of the 50's and 60's; that's my favorite too. One of her greatest highlights was just maybe 2-5 years ago, when she attended "Cher's Live Performance" out West with her cousin, Pam. She liked to have never come down from the ceiling, from seeing Cher!

I loved to hear Charlotte's laugh and giggle. I already miss her so much. I'm thankful to God that Charlotte was my friend.

My many thoughts and continued prayers for her daughter Amanda and grandson Tyler and fiancé, her brother Clarence and Linda, and the dozens of cousins.
