Paul Christian "Chris" Simmons was born in Santa Barbara, California on Friday, August 31, 1945 the son of Paul E. and Frances J. (Jenni) Simmons. Chris passed away on Tuesday, January 19, 2016. He was 70 years old. Chris was active in Boy Scouts when his dad was Scout Master of Troop 104 and spent many summers camping, as well as attending Philmont Scout Ranch in New Mexico.
