Clarence Albert "Cotton" Headrick was born on Wednesday, July 10, 1940 at Peggs, Oklahoma, the son of Clinton and Clarsia (Keeton) Headrick. He passed this life at Hillcrest Medical Center in Tulsa, Oklahoma on Sunday, March 19, 2023. He was 82 years, 8 months and 9 days of age.

Cotton was a 1958 graduate of Tahlequah, Oklahoma high school. He received an associate's degree in Business from Tulsa Junior College. Cotton worked as a mail carrier for the United States Postal Service. He was also a partner with his son at All Season Equipment for some 15 years. Cotton was a veteran of the United States Air Force, having served during the Vietnam War. He was a lifetime member of the Veterans of Foreign Wars, Broken Arrow Post #10887.
