



## Dale Strauser

April 26, 1937 - February 24, 2017

A memorial service honoring the life of Dale Strauser has been scheduled for 10:00 AM, Tuesday, April 11, 2017 at the Missouri State Veterans Cemetery in Bloomfield, Missouri.

Dale Strauser was born on Monday, April 26, 1937 in Cape Girardeau, Missouri the son of Doyle and Ina (Davis) Strauser. Dale died on Friday, February 24, 2017 in Broken Arrow, Oklahoma. He was 79 years of age. Dale graduated high school in Cape Girardeau, Missouri and went on to receive his Associate's Degree in Business. He was a Sergeant Major in the United States Army, serving in the Korean War and 3 tours in the Vietnam war. Dale retired in 1986 after 28 years in military service.

Dale married Miss Carolyn Correll on November 26, 1972 in a Cape Girardeau wedding ceremony. Their union was blessed with 2 daughters and 1 son. Dale enjoyed spending time with his family.
