



Daniel Mallowney

April 27, 1956 - November 3, 2024

Daniel Thomas Mallowney, 68, was born in Brooklyn, NY on April 27, 1956. While still a toddler, his family moved to Philadelphia, PA and finally to Oklahoma in the early 1970s.

He valiantly fought COPD for many years until God called him home peacefully from the Porta Caeli (Gate of Heaven in Latin) House at Catholic Charities in Tulsa on November 3, 2024 with his wife by his side.

Daniel was one of seven siblings, preceded in death by his beloved sister, Nancy and beloved brothers, Steve and Peter Mallowney. He is survived by his wife, Marie, his loving mother, Dorothy (92), three sisters, Maureen Ashley and her husband, Gerald and their family, Teresa Mallowney and her husband, Joe Stallings and their family and Jenny Payne and her husband, David and their family.

Dan's career began as a printer at Cities Service, then computer operator with Citigo, Sabre, and EDS, and lastly as a mail room worker at DHS (Dept of Human Services in Tulsa), his favorite job of all as he helped people more in that job than any other.

Dan lived his faith in God. He genuinely loved all of his co-workers and very much enjoyed laughing with them with his always present sense of humor. Fishing was a favorite past-time of Dan's and now joins his fishing buddies from over the years, including his wife's dad, his best friend, in Heaven.

He will be dearly missed by the many people who were blessed to know him and who blessed Dan with their friendship and help, especially in his final

years and days.

The funeral Mass will be held at 10:00AM on Saturday, November 16 at Church of St. Benedict, 2200 W. Ithica St in Broken Arrow, OK 74012 (between 91st and 101st on 145/Aspen).

Immediately following the service, Dan's ashes will be interred at Calvary Cemetery in Tulsa.
