Danny (Dan) Lee Marshall, 77, passed to his heavenly home on April 10, 2025, surrounded by his loving wife and two sons. Dan was born in Tulsa on July 11, 1947, the son of Robert and Bessie Marshall.

After graduating high school, Dan joined the armed forces and served his country by becoming a United States Marine. Soon after, he met his sweetheart, JoAnn, at Glenhaven Free Methodist church. They were married on May 19, 1970, and would share life together for the next 55 years.

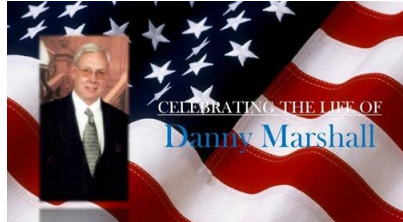

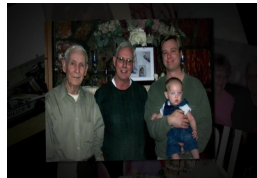
