“David and I first met during football team practice at Hamilton Terrace Junior High in Shreveport. It was early September, 1947 as we were starting 7th grade.

There was excitement about beginning that first year at a new school, and for me a special excitement about going out for football. Hamilton Terrace was the only junior high in town back then (they are now called middle schools). There were three grades; 7th, 8th and 9th and also three football teams. Teams competed in Shreveport Recreation Department leagues based on body weight limits of 85, 105 and 125 pounds. David and I played that first year on the 85 pound team called the “Terrors”. David was our left guard and I played right guard. We won the city championship and not only were we undefeated and untied, no team scored against us. That next year we moved up to the 105 pound league and won all but one game. Unfortunately, those were the highlights of most of our football careers. One team member became an All-State quarterback at Byrd High followed by 3 years as the starting quarterback at Tulane University in New Orleans. Another team member became an accomplished newspaper sports writer and editor.

Those junior high years included lots of other special times with our close-knit group of friends, including baseball and basketball games, Friday night dances at Shreveport’s Princess Park Recreation Center, Saturday afternoon movies (we called them picture shows) at the Centenary Theater, riding bicycles and motor scooters, the occasional hayrides, swimming at the Municipal Pool, and of course girls.

Nearly all of our group have now passed. Although David and I had not seen each other but one time in later years, more recently we would visit by phone. He was a great friend. I’ll miss him.
