Delroy M. Huntsman was born Saturday, July 22, 1933 in Rochester, Texas to Ralph and Esther (Buckner) McGuire. She left this earth Friday, December 23, 2022 at the age of 89.

Del graduated from Rochester High School at the age of 15. After graduation she worked at the Home State Bank in Rochester, and later at the Haskell National Bank in Haskell, Texas. Del went on her first date with Pete on December 14, 1949 and after a courtship of 16 months they were married on April 27, 1951 in Abilene, Texas. Pete was in the Army when they married and they lived in Fort Smith, Arkansas and later in Ft. Riley, Kansas. After his completion of service they moved back to Rochester and welcomed two sons while living there. The family moved to Bartlesville, then to Broken Arrow in 1964.

Del worked at the First National Bank in Broken Arrow and enjoyed working there for about ten years. She was a member of the Broken Arrow church of Christ, where she was very involved in the ladies program and teaching children's bible classes for years. She also enjoyed working on cross-stitch projects and making quilts for her loved ones.

Pete and Del enjoyed traveling with friends from church and spending time at their place at Lake Eufaula. She loved spending time with her grandchildren and great grandchildren and always looked forward to their visits.

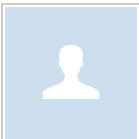
