



## Don Brooks

April 17, 1935 - August 4, 2019

Donald was born in Broken Arrow, Oklahoma on April 17, 1935 to Clarence and Hazel Brooks. Donald passed away in Broken Arrow, Oklahoma on Sunday, August 4, 2019 at the age of 84.

Donald was a product of Broken Arrow Public Schools with the exception of a short stint during which the family moved to Okmulgee. While in Okmulgee, Donald's slow pitch softball team traveled to Boise, Idaho where they won the 1949 National Championship. Don graduated from Broken Arrow High School with the class of 1953. After attending college at Oklahoma A&M and Northeastern State University he enlisted in the Air Force where he was stationed in Tripoli, Libya and Washington D.C. During his time in Washington D.C. he was very proud to have been assigned to Air Force 2. After an honorable discharge, Don began his career at American Airlines.

On December 19, 1959 Don married the love of his life, Gwen R. Garrett in Tulsa, Oklahoma. They had three children and Donald was an active, hands-on father. He coached little league baseball and softball, he helped out with Cub Scouts and the Pinewood Derby. He was the neighborhood repairman, as all kids knew they could bring whatever was broken to have repaired.

Donald was an incredibly intelligent man with many interests. Over the course of his life, he was a talented painter, wood carver, stained glass artist, and especially gardener. At one time he had 163 different varieties of plants in his yard. What he took care of every year would normally take a team of gardeners. He was fascinated by travel and traveled the world vicariously

through Google Earth and his children's experiences. He loved astronomy and loved gazing up at the moon and stars in the evening. He loved watching the birds and squirrels. He literally had birds and squirrels eating out of his hand. Donald was a wonderful husband, father and grandfather and was an inspiration to all who knew him and was dearly loved.
