



## Edgar L. Weeks

May 2, 1922 - November 11, 2016

Edgar Lee Weeks (94) passed away ironically on Veterans Day, November 11, 2016 in Tulsa, Ok. He was born in New Edinburg, Arkansas on May 2, 1922 to Floyd and Amelia Weeks.

Attending Monticello College in Arkansas at age 17, he joined the National Guard and enlisted in the US Army 505th Infantry Division to fight in WWII. Proud to serve his country, he fought in Africa, Italy and France was awarded 5 Bronze Stars and reached the rank of Lieutenant Colonel. While at a USO dance in North Carolina, he met his wife, Hellon Fisher Weeks. They married on April 6, 1947 and relocated to Oklahoma.

Edgar graduated from University of Oklahoma with his MBA and was hired into the Finance Department of Cities Service Oil Company. Fostered and encouraged by his wife, Hellon, he enjoyed a long and successful career at Cities Service Company as an executive officer in many capacities, retiring in the position of Audit General, Finance Division.

Edgar and his wife celebrated 70 years of happiness together. After retirement, they enjoyed traveling the world and spending time with their family. He is remembered as an honest, caring man and devoted husband and father.

Edgar is survived by his wife, Hellon Fisher Weeks, daughter Rebecca Weeks Carter, son-in-law Ron Carter, daughter Betty Lee Weeks, granddaughters Carrie Carter Cheatham, Joy Carter Bentley, Heather Carter Gaba, their husbands, 5 great grandchildren and sister Montine Weeks Dobbs.
