



## Finley "Bo" L Moffat, Jr

January 10, 1929 - September 29, 2023

Finley L. Moffatt, Jr. was born on Thursday, January 10, 1929 in New Albany, Mississippi, the son of Finley L. and Lillie (Thomas) Moffatt, Sr. He passed this life on Friday, September 29, 2023 at Trinity Woods Assisted Living in Tulsa, Oklahoma. He was 94 years of age.

Bo was a 1947 graduate of New Albany, Mississippi high school. He received a Bachelor's degree in Business Administration from Mississippi State University where he was a proud member of Sigma Chi Fraternity. Out of college, he began working at a finance company, then insurance sales. He bought the Gulf Oil Distributorship in New Albany and operated it for 20 plus years. He also owned Triangle Realty in New Albany for many years. He was elected Mayor of his hometown in 1976, serving 1 year. Bo married the former Miss Virginia M. Marbury on July 21, 1949 in Tupelo, Mississippi. She preceded him in death on January 30, 2012. Bo and Virginia moved from New Albany to Tulsa in 1978. He was active as a real estate broker and later became the Dean of Students at Rhema Bible College where he worked until his retirement.
