A memorial service honoring Gary Uhl has been scheduled for 11:00 a.m., Wednesday, January 6, 2015 at Hayhurst Funeral Home Chapel in Broken Arrow, Oklahoma. Gary passed away on Sunday, December 27, 2015. He was 61 years of age.

Born in Port Hueneme, California on July 17, 1954, Gary was the son of Cal and Donna (McFarland) Uhl. Upon graduation from high school, Gary honorably served his country in the United States Navy. He attended Spartan School of Aeronautics and became a Structural Mechanic for American Airlines in June of 1986. 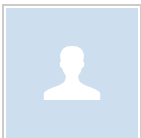

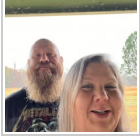
