Gladys was born in Tucker, Missouri on Monday, September 13, 1915, the daughter of Oliver Odell and Ona Agnes (Pulliam) Tucker. She died in Broken Arrow, Oklahoma on Thursday, October 15, 2015. She was 100 years of age.

Gladys was a 1933 graduate of Broken Arrow High School. In June 1937 she married Hugh Coshow, also of Broken Arrow. Members of First United Methodist Church since 1931, Hugh and Gladys were very active in the Church. Gladys was the Secretary and Treasurer and Hugh sang in the choir.

Gladys worked part time as a beauty operator at Tucker Brother's Barber Shop and later for Oklahoma Steel Credit Union. Gladys and Hugh loved playing Pinochle with friends, traveling in their motorhome and spending time with their Boston Terrier, Buffy.

Gladys' survivors include cousins Bob and Peggy Tucker, Joe and Patty Robinson of Broken Arrow, and Connie and Roy Collins, Haskell, and their

families, along with longtime friends, Ron and Sharon Hill, Broken Arrow. She will be missed by friends and staff at Broken Arrow Nursing Home.

She was preceded in death by her parents, and her husband, Hugh.
