Glenda Howard was born the daughter of Carl Bryan and Daisy Keirseay on December 22, 1944, in Pryor, Oklahoma. She was one of five children. After graduating from Pryor High School, she went to Oklahoma Baptist University where she met and married Robert Maxey Charles on May 30th, 1964. After his graduation, they moved back to Robert's home state of Illinois. They had two daughters, Donna Louise and Phyllis Elaine Charles. At a young age, Robert passed away leaving Glenda with two small girls. They eventually returned home to Oklahoma and resided in Tulsa.

She worked for the Tulsa Police Department as a Records Clerk, and upon retirement began her second career as a senior caregiver. She was a natural nurturer and enjoyed the time she spent caring for her clients, some of which considered her a member of their families.
