Gregory Neil Kitch of Broken Arrow, went home to be with The Lord on Thursday, October 7, 2021 at the age of 70.

Greg was born Friday, August 31, 1951 in Kansas City, Missouri to Glenn and Margaret (Whinery) Kitch.
