Greg was born May 3, 1954, in Harrisburg, PA, and was raised in Allentown, PA. Greg received his bachelor's degree from Kutztown University. It was the Army that brought his family to Alaska for over 25 years. Greg held several city management positions in Alaska, Pennsylvania, Massachusetts and Oklahoma.
