Gwendolyn Gale Pharis was born on Saturday, August 24, 1946 in Highland, Illinois, the daughter of Paul and Eula Mae (Titsworth) Farquhar. She passed this life at her home in Tulsa on Saturday, April 2, 2022, surrounded by her family. She was 75 years of age.

The former Miss Gwendolyn Farquhar was a 1964 graduate of Proviso East High School in Maywood, Illinois. She attended Evangel University in Springfield, Missouri, where she met the love of her life. 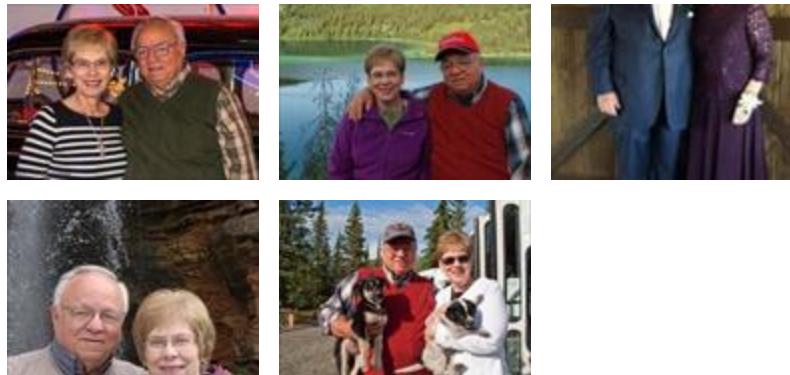
