Helen Elaine Reagan was born in Lyman, Nebraska on Wednesday, April 10, 1929, to Frank and Beulah (Morehouse) Reagan. She passed from this life on Tuesday, January 11, 2022, in Tulsa, Oklahoma at the age of 92.

Helen was one of four children born to the Reagans. She grew up in Falcon, Missouri and attended school there. The family moved to Oklahoma, and she graduated from Central High School in 1946.
