Now you have got to meet my baby boys in heaven and it's hard for me not to be a little jealous of you! Don't fight with nana over them because you know she is hogging them! Nannie you will be missed but my heart is also so happy for you! I know you have missed pop so much and losing nana was just too much for you! I know how much you adored her and as a mother here on earth without two of her children I get it! Nannie I hope I make it to 101 if it's Gods will for my life and I pray I can do it with as much grace and style as you!!! Love you nannie!!!!
