J.O. Work, son of Jimmy and Kathleen Work, was born on Tuesday, March 1, 1938 in Quinton, Oklahoma. He passed this life at St. Francis Hospital in Tulsa on Tuesday, April 13, 2021. He was 83 years of age.

J.O. was a 1956 graduate of Quinton, Oklahoma high school. He married Miss Linda Schell on May 25, 1962 at Capitol Hill Assembly of God Church in Tulsa, Oklahoma. J.O. served the various ministries of Evangelist Oral Roberts for ... as J.O. would say ... 56 years, 3 months, and 6 days (but who's counting) and retired as the Director of Information Systems for Oral Roberts Evangelistic Association and Oral Robert University. 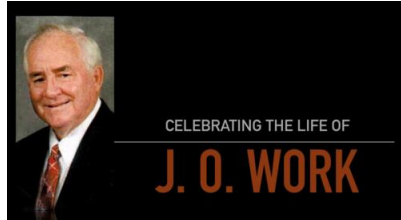

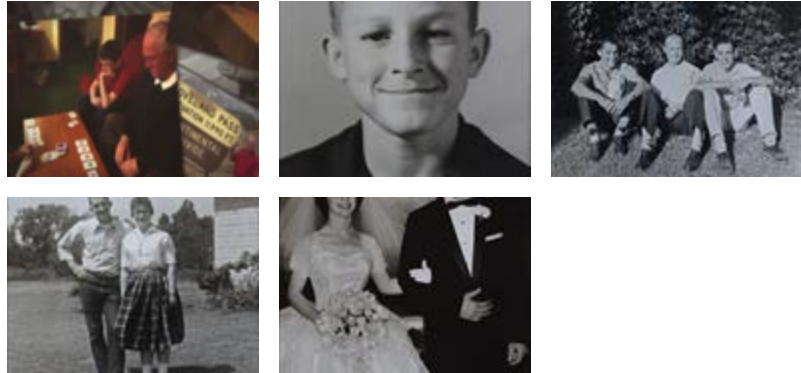
