Jack passed away on Tuesday, December 15, 2015. He was 77.

Born in Tulsa, Oklahoma on August 28, 1938, Jack was the son of Morris and Onie (Billups) Parrott. Jack graduated from Tulsa Central High School in 1956. He faithfully served his country in the United States Air Force as a Jet Mechanic on B-47 aircraft.

On April 5, 1957 Jack married the love of his life, Patsy Joyce Bowden in a Broken Arrow wedding ceremony in her parents' home. Their union was blessed with one daughter Jacki. Jack was a wonderful loving husband and father. He was employed as a Pressman for Oil and Gas Journal before going on to retire from Penn Well Publishing after 38 years. In recent years, Jack and Pat worked together as licensed real estate agents.
