Jack O. Stacy was born on February 20th, 1938 in Tulsa, Oklahoma to Fred O. Stacy and Ann Stacy. He spent his early childhood in Broken Arrow before the family relocated to Okmulgee and eventually back to Tulsa where Jack graduated from Will Rogers High School in 1956 where he was a football player and All-State baseball player. He married in 1958 and was the cherished father to Steve Stacy, Stan Stacy and Rod Stacy. While working hard to support his new family he worked many jobs and still found the time to complete a degree in mathematics from the University of Tulsa.

He served as a firefighter for the City of Tulsa from 1960 to 1965. He worked for a new startup company called Xerox in the 1960's before starting a long career as a residential homebuilder. He built hundreds of homes in the Tulsa Metro as well as commercial and residential remodels.

Jack loved the Lord and never met a stranger. He taught lessons of love, respect, hard work generosity and humility to his children and grandchildren by his example.

He was called home to be reunited with the Lord and his family on October 10th, 2024.

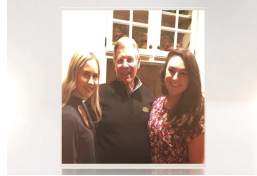

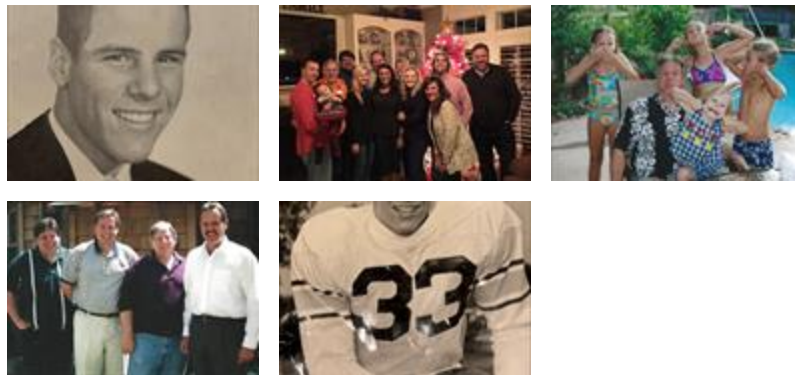
