



Jackie "J.R." Ray Mosteller

June 26, 1931 - July 4, 2024

Jackie Ray Mosteller was born on Friday, June 26, 1931 in Haskell, OK, the son of Allie Mason and Ida Ellen Pearl (Keaton) Mosteller. He passed this life at his home in Broken Arrow on Thursday, July 4, 2024. He was 93 years of age.

Mr. Mosteller graduated from OSU in 1956 with a B.S. in Mechanical Engineering and attended graduate school at the University of Tulsa. He is a member of the OSU Foundation President's club and The Associates of the College of Business Administration, having served as Vice Chairman and on the Government Relations and Nominating committees. He is a life member of the OSU Alumni Association.

J.R. Mosteller is the former Executive Vice President of ONEOK Inc. in Tulsa. He joined Oklahoma Natural Gas company, a Division of ONEOK, as an Engineer Trainee in 1956, rising through the ranks to serve as President of the company. In addition, he served as President of ONG Transmission Company. Mr. Mosteller assumed the office of Executive Vice President of ONEOK Inc. in 1990, retiring from that position in 1994. He has also served as Chairman of the Board and Director of Tri-Fuels, Inc.

A registered professional engineer, he served as Delegate and Director of the Southern Gas Association and is a member of the National Society of

Professional Engineers and the Oklahoma Independent Petroleum Association.

Jack was married to the former Miss Mary Louise Fultz on December 22, 1952 in Haskell, Oklahoma. She preceded him in death on January 18, 2019.

Jack enjoyed golf, was a member of Cedar Ridge Country Club and taking family and friends out to dinner. He was an elder at Garnett Road Church of Christ, on the Indian Nations Council of Boy Scouts and a Member of the Tulsa Kiwanis Club. He started DOJARO at Tenkiller Lake. His greatest love was spending time with his family, especially his grandchildren.
