



## Rev. Jackie "Jack" Martin

October 26, 1936 - April 19, 2018

Rev. Jack Martin, 81, of Tulsa, passed away Thursday, April 19, 2018. A funeral service honoring his life will be held 10:00 a.m., Friday, April 27, 2018 at Woodlake Church with burial following at Floral Haven Memorial Gardens. Friends may visit Jack at the funeral home Thursday, April 26, 2018 from 11:00 am till 8:00 pm with the family receiving friends from 5:00 pm till 7:00 pm.

Jack was born Monday, October 26, 1936 in Miami, Oklahoma to Ernest and Mildred (Mathews) Martin.

Jack married the love of his life, Alice Johnson June, 1956 in Tulsa, Oklahoma. Their union was blessed with three children, daughters Janice and Tamara, and son Dean.

Rev. Martin was anointed with the power to heal at the age of 9 and followed his passion for the Lord and preaching by serving as Senior Pastor of Lewis Avenue Church. He served Oral Roberts University for 43 years as their Director of Electronics and Maintenance. 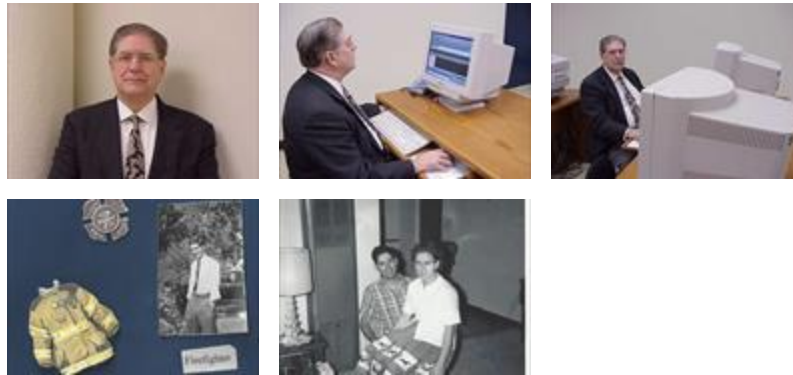

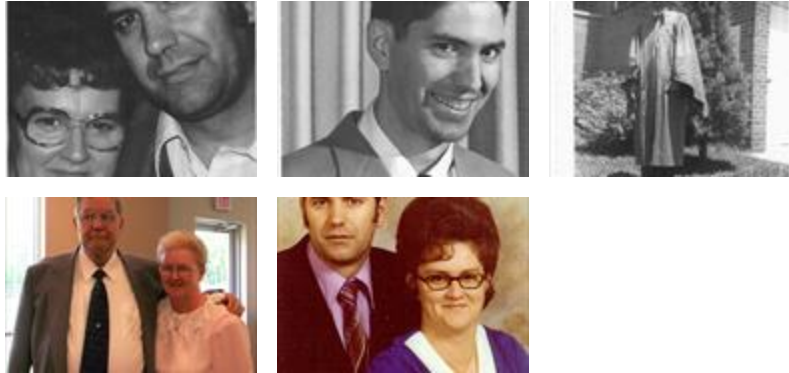
