Jaletta Irene Fisher was born in Broken Arrow, Oklahoma on Monday, February 13, 1956, to Robert Sterling and Vorcie “Jane” (Burt) Young. She passed from this life surrounded by her family to her eternal home in heaven on Thursday, August 5, 2021, in Tulsa, Oklahoma at the age of 65.

Jaletta was the youngest and only daughter of three children born to the Youngs. She had two older brothers and the family was close-knit their entire lives. Jaletta overcame many challenges in recent years. She cared for both of her parents in their final years of life. In fact, she enjoyed walking many mornings with her good friend, Dee. But she didn't just walk again, she went on adventure after adventure. She enjoyed vacationing with her family and friends to locations such as Colorado, Jamaica, Puerto Rico, Branson, Florida, Texas, Alabama, Kentucky, Kansas, and Mexico.

Her children describe Jaletta as selfless, ornery, strong, stubborn and a woman of faith who loved Jesus. She always made sure she had her children in church. She will be missed by all who knew and loved her.
