Services honoring the life of James White Logan, Jr will be at 10:00a.m., Tuesday, March 7, 2017 at St. Anne Catholic Church, Broken Arrow, OK. A rosary will take place at 7:00 p.m., Monday at Hayhurst Funeral Home, Broken Arrow.

Jim was born in Panama, OK on October 16, 1920 to James White Logan, Sr and Ethel "Ruth" (Little) Logan. He passed away on Thursday, March 2, 2017 at the age of 96.

Jim graduated from high school in Poteau., OK where he was an outstanding athlete. He walked on to the Oklahoma A&M football team in 1937. He earned a B.S. in Agriculture Economics, was a member and president of Lambda Chi Alpha fraternity and a member of Blue Key.

Jim honorably served his country in the United States Army during World War II and earned five bronze stars during his active duty. He was a Company Commander and an Infantry Captain assigned to the 158th Regimental Combat Team serving in the Pacific Theatre for 4 years. During his service he was involved in campaigns in New Guinea, the liberation of the Philippine Islands, the invasion of Noemfoor Island, and the occupation of Japan. He

was a true representative of the GREATEST GENERATION.

While at Oklahoma A&M Jim met his soon-to-be wife, Mary Sue Lewis. They married June 28th, 1942 at Camp Robinson, AR, a union of 75 years. Shortly after the wedding Jim was deployed overseas where he served until the war ended.

Following his return, the union was blessed with a daughter and five sons. Jim was a family man, devoted to his wife, his children and his grandchildren.

In 1960 Jim purchased Booster Feed Mills in Tulsa, OK. He served numerous ranchers, dairies, and poultry farms in the Tulsa area. Jim operated Booster Feed Mill until 1992 and was widely respected for his knowledge and expertise in animal nutrition and husbandry.

Throughout his life, Jim was a lifelong sports fan. He was an avid Oklahoma State University booster and a decades long season football ticket holder. He was always in attendance during his children's and grandchildren's sporting events.

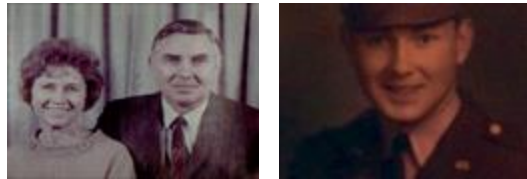
