Mary Janette (Cosper) Francy was born in Logan County, Arkansas on December 20, 1938, to parents John and Bertha Cosper. She transitioned from this life, surrounded by family, on Friday August 30, 2024, in Broken Arrow, OK at the age of 85.

Janette attended Broken Arrow High School, where she played the alto saxophone in the band and was a talented baton twirler. She began dating Kenneth Francy during high school and they were married in December 1957, six months following her graduation.

She began working for National Car Rental shortly after graduation in the role of secretary. She remained employed there until she retired as Office Manager in 2003 after 44 years of service. She loved attending bluegrass and gospel music events and over the years played the piano, autoharp and ukulele. Her family remembers annual garden tours on Mother's Day where they could all enjoy the fruits of her labor.

Janette was a loving mother, grandmother and great-grandmother who would do anything for her family. She will be dearly missed by all whose life she touched.
