Jeff Stevens was born in Tulsa, Oklahoma on Monday, July 9, 1962 the youngest of three children to Ted and Sharon (Russell) Stevens. He passed from this life on Sunday, October 18, 2020 in Tulsa at the age of 58.

Growing up, Jeff's family moved to several different places as his father worked for Polaroid and Kimberly Clark. Jeff's family moved around the Midwest and by the time Jeff reached high school, they had settled in Tulsa and he played varsity football for Union High School, graduating in 1980. 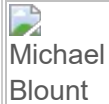
