



## Jerry Wayne Fryer

August 16, 1939 - March 10, 2023

Jerry was born on Wednesday, August 16, 1939, in Hominy, Oklahoma to Ben and Velma Joy (Griswold) Fryer. Jerry passed away on Friday, March 10, 2023, in Tulsa, Oklahoma at 83.

Jerry graduated from Tulsa Central High School and went on to attend Oklahoma State University. He enlisted in the ARMY and was assigned to the 661st Ord Co., Fourth ARMY (Major Command), later transferring to the USAR Control Group US ARMY CORPS. Jerry also worked and retired from the United States Postal Service and The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints. On November 29, 1963, Jerry married Carlyn Faye East in Tulsa, Oklahoma. Their union was blessed with six children.

Jerry was a great conversationalist, he enjoyed discussing many different subjects, including history, art, music, and religion. He was a huge sports buff who enjoyed a good game, especially football. Jerry enjoyed riding his motorcycle, duck hunting with Father-in-law, fishing, and watching Jacques Cousteau, history, current events, and politics. He took classes for real estate, became an auctioneer after attending the oldest auctioneer school in the world, Missouri Auction School, and pursued an art degree at Tulsa University. He made the mosaic that hung in the entryway of their family home. He was an amateur photographer, having a photo published in the Tulsa World contest. He took a few stained-glass classes and knew how to bake bread,

and it was delicious. Jerry loved his church and having the missionaries over to the house and taking them to eat. His greatest joy was spending time with his family.

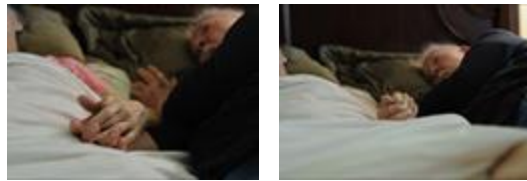

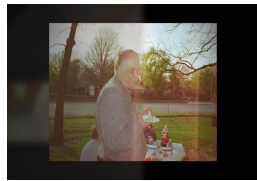
