Jo Ann Wilson was born on Tuesday, August 25, 1931, in Tulsa, Oklahoma, the daughter of Joseph and Bessie (Anderson) Terrell. She passed away on Monday, September 16, 2024, at St. Francis Hospital in Tulsa, Oklahoma. She was 93 years of age.

Jo Ann was a 1949 graduate of Tulsa Central High School. She married John “Bobby” Wilson, Jr. on January 24, 1953 in Tulsa, Oklahoma. She owned and operated Jo Wilson and Associates as a Real Estate Broker. She was also the Chief Financial Officer and Bookkeeper for Metro Wilson Tire Company for fifty years, which was owned and operated by her husband, Bobby. Jo Ann partnered with her daughter, Joy, to run a wedding business called Cameo Weddings. They had the business for ten years. Jo Ann loved to shop, watch football, take trips to Branson, and do anything with her family, especially her grandchildren and great-grandchildren. Family vacations and dinners were her favorite times. She was a past member of Woodlake Church and, most recently, a member of Carbondale Assembly, both in Tulsa.
