Joe Dale McClure was born on Monday, March 17, 1947 in Tulsa, Oklahoma, the son of John Samuel and Sarah Louise (Bailey) McClure. He passed this life on Wednesday, March 13, 2024 at St. Francis Hospital in Tulsa. He was 76 years, 11 months and 25 days of age.

Joe was a 1965 graduate of Lawton Eisenhower High School. He was a Veteran of the United States Army having served two tours in Vietnam in the 1st Infantry Division Big Red One, 121st Signal Battalion, Charlie Company, where he was awarded the Purple Heart and 2 Bronze Stars. He was married to the former Miss Coleen Deutsch on July 15, 1978 in Ambridge, Pennsylvania. Joe was an Iron Worker, having worked for Braden Steel, Harmon Steel and most recently American Glass, working on the BOK Center.
