A celebration of the life of John S. Sills has been scheduled for 2:00 p.m., Friday, October 28, 2016 at First Baptist Church in Broken Arrow, Oklahoma. John passed away on Monday, October 24, 2016 in Tulsa, Oklahoma. He was 74 years of age.

John was born on Monday, February 3, 1942 in Prescott, Arizona, the son of John Francis and Mary Alice (Steele) Sills. John graduated in 1961 from Prescott High School before going on to earn his Bachelor's degree in Psychology from the University of Arizona in Tucson. After college, John was drafted by Armstrong Flooring Company. He later opened his own flooring store in Oklahoma City. John went on to become a sales manager in Wholesale Flooring, until his retirement in 2007.

From a previous marriage, John was blessed with two daughters. On January 3, 1981 John married Naomi Stroud in a Tulsa wedding ceremony and they were blessed with four more children. Johnny, as his family lovingly referred to him, was a wonderful husband, father, grandfather and great grandfather. He loved his family and enjoyed spending time with them.

In his free time, John, sometimes called "Slats" by his golfing buddies loved to be out on the course. He also enjoyed fishing and just being outdoors. John was an avid football fan and especially loved the Dallas Cowboys and
