Jolene McNeal was born in the beautiful plains and wheat fields of Midwest Kansas in the very small town of Lucas on July 23, 1936. She also lived with her folks, Helen and Ray Schneider, on the family wheat farm with her grandparents, Joe and Josephine Somer, and a bunch of uncles and aunts. It was truly a "family farm."

Jolene would tell stories of getting chased out of the watermelon patch and being chased by ducks and chickens on the farm. That farmhouse is still there in Luray, Russell County, Kansas and very much a part of our family history. Eventually, Jolene moved with Helen and Ray to Wilson, Kansas and graduated from Wilson High School. She met a handsome young man from a neighboring town, Dorrance, Kansas. But he wasn't a Kansas boy, he had come from Tulsa, Oklahoma to work in Dorrance and attend high school. Jack and Jolene were married at the First Methodist Church in Wilson on November 1954 and moved to the nearby town of Russell, Kansas. Soon Jolene and Jack moved back to Tulsa with their first daughter, Sherry Lynn. Then more girls arrived, Debra Sue and Donna Kay. All the girls were

born within a span of 6 years. Jolene was an amazing mom, wrangling three mischievous girls, while working outside the home, keeping a lovely house and putting dinner on the table every night. The very doted-upon boy, Michael James, came along 10 years after Donna, so Jolene had kids around for quite some time.

Jolene and Jack loved family vacations, camping family holidays and collecting Jim Beam whiskey bottles, antiques, Fenton art glass, Longaberger baskets. And cats.

Jolene worked from the time she graduated from Wilson High School. She worked at a law firm, she worked at a tag agency in north Tulsa, she worked at Owasso Tag Agency where she retired in 1995. But she didn't really retire then, she managed the family bicycle shop, Wheels of Owasso.

Jolene's grandson, Ryan Hill, preceded her in death in July 2017.

Jolene leaves behind her devoted husband, Jack B. McNeal of Owasso; Sherry and Roger Hill; Mike McNeal and Stefanie Terry; Donna and Chris Ohler, all of Broken Arrow. Debby Sallis and Chuck Harrington of Tulsa. Grandchildren include Katherine Ann Sallis and Martin Futrel of Oklahoma City, OK; Suzanne Kaye Hill-Wyatt and Taylor Wyatt of Fayetteville, Arkansas; Cole "Mac" Sallis of Tulsa; Jolene's only great grandbaby, Jade Ann Futrel. 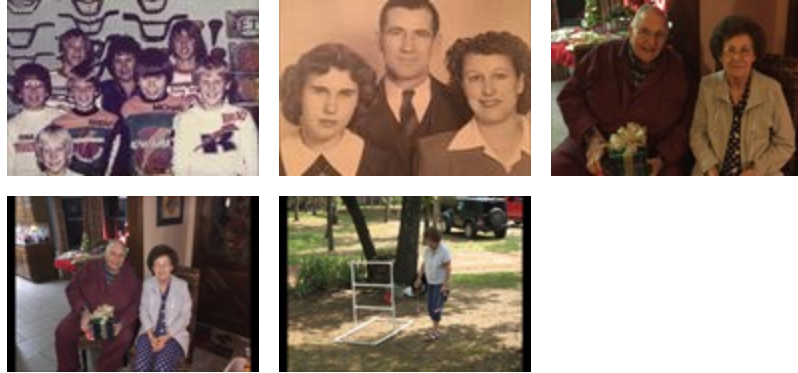

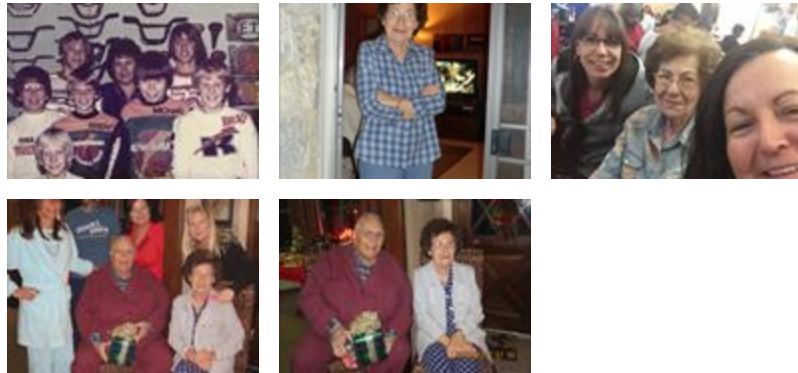
