Joseph Bryant "Joe" Cole was born on Monday, September 3, 1928 in Okmulgee, Oklahoma the son of Joseph B. Cole, Sr. and Mala (Whitlock) Cole. Joe passed away on Friday, May 26, 2017 in Tulsa, Oklahoma at the age of 88.

Joe graduated high school and went on to earn a Bachelor's degree from Missouri School of Mines, Rolla, Missouri. Joe proudly served his country in the United States Marine Corps until his honorable discharge in August of 1948. After his military duty Joe held positions in the oil and gas industry including jobs with Foxboro of Borger, TX and Cabot of Pampa, TX. Joe retired from Wilbros Engineering at age 70 but continued to work as a consultant.

On July 14, 1951 Joe married Irene Mary Kloeppel in Kingfisher, Oklahoma.

Their union was blessed with three sons and a daughter. Joe was a wonderful husband and father. He loved his children and grandchildren and enjoyed spending time with them. In his free time, Joe liked fishing, boating, traveling extensively, reading and feeding the birds. Joe was an Eagle Scout in his youth and later he enjoyed volunteering with the Boy and Girl Scouts.
